9-10	MONTHS	HEP B
12-13	MONTHS	MMR AND VARICELLA
15-16	MONTHS	HIB AND PREVNAR
18-19	MONTHS	DTAP AND HEP A
2-3	YEARS	HEP A
4	YEARS	MMR AND VARIVAX (PROQUAD) DTAP AND POLIO (QUADRACEL)
10	YEARS	TDAP
11	YEARS	MENACTRA
12	YEARS	GARDASIL
16-18	YEARS	MENACTRA AND MENINGITIS B (TRUMBENBA)

Notes: MUST be 6 weeks of age to receive 1st Rotavirus vaccine (oral)
MUST be on or after 1st birthday to receive MMR and Varicella

Gardasil is a 2 or 3 dose series depending on patient's age at 1st dose
Meningitis B (Trumenba) is a dose series 6-12 months apart

PENTACEL: Combination of DTAP, HIB and Polio
PROQUAD: Combination of MMR and Varivax
QUADRACEL: Combination of Dtap and Polio
